The Office of the Basic Education Commission has a policy for School to comply with the Constitution on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E.2108, section 126 paragraph one that stipulates that No government officers shall receive any property or any other benefit which may be calculated in the form of money from any person. Other than assets or reasonable benefits under the law, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the law and except for the receipt of assets or any other benefits in an ethical manner in accordance with the rules and amounts prescribed by the NACC ITA and according to the Civil Service Code of Ethics, Article 6(1), which specifies not to demand, accept or accept or allow others to demand, accept or accept gifts on behalf of themselves or their relatives, whether before or after holding office or performing duties whether related to or not related to the performance of duties unless it is given by ethics or is a traditional gift or to the general public

In order to prevent corruption and misconduct of government officials All staff and personnel in Hotpittayakom School is aware of corruption. It is an important problem that all sectors must work together to eliminate. The operating in accordance with the policy of the Office of the Basic Education Commission and A Declaration of Intent to Administrate Hotpittayakom School with Honesty & Integrity, there is a policy of not accepting gifts in all festivals (No Gift Policy) “Change gift to be blessings”. This is to avoid actions that may affect discretion or decision-making in the performance of duties, which leads to discrimination or creates a conflict of interest.
